PROJECT

2020 Liberty Lake Throwdown T-Shirt Design

The Friends of Pavillion Park and Throwdown Committee, is now accepting designs for the 2020 Liberty Lake Throwdown Participant T-shirt. Deadline for submitting designs is Friday, May 15, 2020. The selected artist will receive \$300 for the design selected. Entries should be submitted to Dropbox as detailed below.

The design can have up to 3 colors (there will also be a one-color imprint of the sponsor logo on the sleeve). Artist can recommend a shirt color, although the final decision will rest with Throwdown Committee. The words Liberty Lake Throw Down and 2020 (or '20) must be incorporated into the design.

Design must be able to transfer well in the screen-printing process. The design and color of the inaugural shirt is included below.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

April 6 through May 15

The Friends of Pavillion Park is seeking t-shirt designs for participants of the 2020 Liberty Lake Throw Down cornhole tournament.

ELIGIBILITY

This project is open to all professional and amateur artists and other creative individuals and groups.

T-SHIRT DESIGN REQUIREMENTS AND SUBMISSION DETAILS

Artists are invited to submit up to four (4) files for consideration.

Submitted designs must be original works of the artist and in compliance with all existing copyright laws. Due to the public nature of the project, artwork shall not contain advertising, religious art, sexual, violent or other content unsuitable for all ages and cannot convey political partisanship.

Requirements

No more than three (3) colors

Design should be no larger than 13 inches high by 11 inches wide

Image Title: All submissions shall be titled. File format shall be as follows: lastname.firstname.submission number.


File Submission: Submissions should be uploaded to the following Dropbox following the file naming parameters. Artists may submit up to four (4) designs for consideration.
